God's name disrespected

What's missing in the following scriptures?

<u>Isaiah 26:4 KJB - Trust</u> ye in the LORD for ever: for in the LORD <u>JEHOVAH</u> is everlasting strength: <u>Isaiah 26:4 NKJV - Trust</u> in the LORD forever, For in YAH, the LORD, is everlasting strength.

<u>Psalm 83:18 KJB -</u> That men may know that thou, whose name alone is <u>JEHOVAH</u>, art the most high over all the earth.

<u>Psalm 83:18 NKJV -</u> That they may know that You, whose name alone is the LORD, Are the Most High over all the earth.

<u>Exodus 6:3 KJB -</u> And I appeared unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, by the name of God Almighty, but by my name <u>JEHOVAH</u> was I not known to them.

<u>Exodus 6:3 NKJV -</u> I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, as God Almighty, but by My name LORD I was not known to them.

How many times is God's name Jehovah in the Bible? 7 Times! It isn't is NKJV at all, totally omitted!

Comments: Other modern versions took out Satan's name Lucifer. NKJV decided to keep Lucifer's name and get rid of God's.

God's son disrespected

<u>Acts 3:13 KJB -</u> The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let him go.

<u>Acts 3:13 NKJV</u> - The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the God of our fathers, glorified His Servant Jesus, whom you delivered up and denied in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let Him go.

<u>Acts 3:26 KJB -</u> Unto you first God, having raised up his Son Jesus, sent him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities.

<u>Acts 3:26 NKJV -</u> To you first, God, having raised up His Servant Jesus, sent Him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from your iniquities."

The word "Lord" is watered down

<u>Luke 13:8 KJB</u> - And he answering said unto him, <u>Lord</u>, let it alone this year also, till I shall dig about it, and dung it:

<u>Luke 13:8 NKJV</u> - But he answered and said to him, 'Sir, let it alone this year also, until I dig around it and fertilize it.

<u>Matthew 18:26 KJB</u> - The servant therefore fell down, and worshipped him, saying, Lord, have patience with me, and I will pay thee all.

<u>Matthew 18:26 NKJV</u> - The servant therefore fell down before him, saying, 'Master, have patience with me, and I will pay you all.'

Attack on Jesus' diety

<u>Acts 4:27 KJB</u> - For of a truth against thy holy child Jesus, whom thou hast anointed, both Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together,

<u>Acts 4:27 NKJV</u> - For truly against Your holy Servant Jesus, whom You anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles and the people of Israel, were gathered together

How hard is it to get saved? It's easy!!

Romans 6:23 KJB - For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Romans 10:9 KJV - That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

NKJV tells us it's harder to get saved

Matthew 7:14 KJB - Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

Matthew 7:14 NKJV - Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.

Comments: The NKJV bible is not a King James Bible – It's a vegetable soup bible. It's takes the Textus Receptus and mixes it with other modern versions.
